Year of St. Joseph lasts from 8 December 2020 through 8 December 2021 on the occasion of the 150th anniversary of the proclamation of St. Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church.

Indulgence is a remission before God of the Temporal Punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven at the sacrament of Confession...It can be **partial** or **plenary** according as it removes either part or all the temporal punishment due to sin. It may be applied to the living or the dead. (cf. CCC, # 1471).

Temporal punishment is the punishment that remains after the guilt of sin has been forgiven upon going to a Sacramental Confession to a validly ordained Catholic Priest (cf. CCC, # 1472-73).

What the above means is that when one commits sin, he/she incurs a *double consequence*; the eternal and temporal punishments. If the person repents and goes to confession, the eternal punishment is taken care of while the temporal punishment remains. The person will have to work out the removal of the “temporal punishments” by himself/herself. If that is not done and the person dies, he/she will remain in **PURGATORY** until those ‘Temporal Punishments’ are cleared. One of the ways to remove the accumulated temporal punishments is through the gaining of **INDULGENCE** (cf. CCC. #1471, 1474-79).

Fortunately, the Church has granted “**Plenary Indulgence**” to all those who will fulfil the following on this **Year of St. Joseph**:

1. **Sacramental Confession.**
2. **Go to mass and receive Holy Communion.**
3. **Pray for the Pope’s intentions** (usually, 1 Our Father, 3 Hail Mary, 1 Glory be...).
4. **Pray any of the Church’s approved prayer to St. Joseph.**

01 May, the Feast of St. Joseph the Worker.

Every Wednesday, a day dedicated to the saint in the Latin Tradition.
