Good News Reflection Be bold with your good news!

Think of a time when you were in darkness: a sin, for example, or when you felt abandoned by God or your prayers seemed dry and your spiritual gifts seemed covered over. What did



Jesus say to you at that time (perhaps through scripture or friends or a homily at Mass)? What did his whisperings tell you? His words and his guidance were good news for you!

In this Sunday's Gospel reading, Jesus says: "What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light."

He's calling you and commissioning you and empowering you, through his Holy Spirit, to share your good news with others, so that they can hear him in their darkness. Proclaim it boldly and visibly so that those who want to hear it will stop and listen. Do not be afraid to openly share how Jesus has been working in your life and how he's helped you grow or heal or turn away from sin.

Yes, when we're this bold, some people ridicule us and reject us, like how Jeremiah was treated in the first reading. But the Lord is with you, too, as "a mighty champion," and your persecutors will eventually stumble and fail. Jesus tells us to "fear no one." God takes good care of us.

Jesus acknowledges those who acknowledge him. In other words, when we're insulted or persecuted for our faith, God holds us and comforts us. It's his opinion of us that matters anyway, and no one else's. Listen to him. In the whispers of the sanctuary of your heart, he's telling you all the good that he sees in you. He's telling you that he appreciates the good you have done. He's giving you good news worth sharing.

Sunday Evening Mass Time Review

Dear parishioners, we have now completed a trial period of one year since we changed the Sunday evening Mass time from 6pm to 5pm. It is time to review this decision and see if we are happy to continue with the Mass at 5pm or not. A major consideration for the change was to make Mass and the sacraments more accessible to more of our parishioners, particularly to young families whose children need to go to bed early. You can find a double-sided information sheet "Considerations that led to the Decision to Change the Sunday evening Mass time from 6pm to 5pm" available at the back of the GA Church this weekend outlining the rationale for introducing the change. Since May last year, the change has allowed us to run school-led Masses where each Year-level has led the readings, singing and other various parts of the Mass, as well as the regular Children's Liturgy of the Word that is run each fortnight for children in Prep to Year 3/4. It has been great to deepen the children's faith life through their participation with their families in the liturgical life of the Church. We will conduct the review by means of a survey form for those attending the 5pm Mass on Sunday, 25th June. If you are a regular at the Sunday evening Mass, but can't make it along that day and would still like to let us know what you think, feel free to contact the Parish Office. Thank you.
